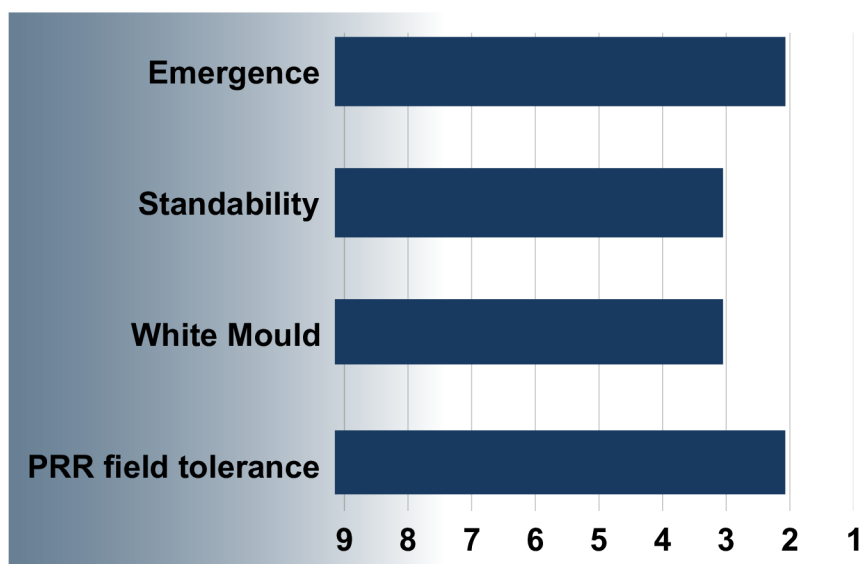
SCN resistance
