Top-end yield with agronomics to support it. Medium-short plant that bushes out to fill in the rows. Excellent standability, making it well-suited for high yield environments. Easy to find 4 bean pods (see photo).



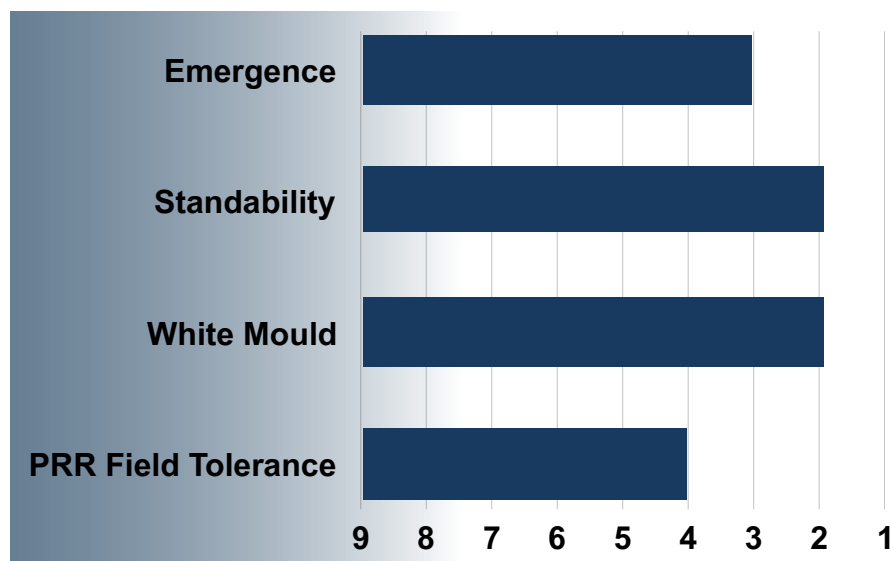
